Minutes of the Quarterly Membership Meeting

October 23, 2023

The Lake Jordan Home Owners/Boat Owners Association Quarterly Membership Meeting was called to order by President Kim Adams at 7:00pm on October 23, 2023, at the Outdoor Basketball Court Pavilion at Camp Chandler on Lake Jordan.

Kim recognized and thanked Al Hannon with the Buyck Volunteer Fire Department for coming ahead of Haynes Life Flight helicopter to prepare the landing site. She also recognized and thanked Rusty Redden and John Wilson from Holtville Fire Department for their support in various HOBO events. Commissioner Henry Hines was present and also recognized.

President Adams welcomed and thanked everyone for being there and declared that a quorum was present to conduct business.

Financial report prepared by Brett Wilkinson was presented by President Adams and included the following discussions: Excess funds from Lake Clean Up would be moved into the Scholarship Fund for a total of \$3,400. After discussion, Tim Owen made a motion to transfer the remaining funds from the cleanup to the Scholarship Fund, motion was seconded by several members and the motion was carried by unanimous agreement.

The Financial Report dated September 2023, showed an ending non-restricted cash balance of \$65,364.30 and a set budget to be approved January 2024 was discussed.

Committee Reports

Lake Safety – Dave Kowalski discussed buoys and new placements.

Fireworks – Ann Brantley and Alaina Starke were recognized as the new chairs of the Fireworks Committee. Nikki Miller and Jill Murchinson will be assisting them with t-shirt sales and ensuring a smooth transition.

Coosa River Basin/Environmental – President Adams gave a quick report in the absence of Committee Chairs Steve and Linda Mathies. Alabama Power did finish the rock weir upgrade and a redigging of the sand trap in the back of Sears Slough. County Commissioners have identified the source of the sediment in Sears Slough as a private property owner's retaining pond after a meeting with Engineers. Discussions of the ever-changing lake in slough growths and shrinkages continued as this issue is a concern for many homeowners.

Memorial and Worship – The speaker system at Bonner's Chapel and Boat Ramp needs an upgrade. Approval of a one-time increase to the budget not to exceed \$1,200 was approved for the upgrade. The system will be kept on-site in a secure facility.

Minutes of the Quarterly Membership Meeting—Continued (Pg 2)

Guest Speaker – With the cooperation of Camp Chandler, Buyck VFD and Haynes LifeFlight crew, we had the opportunity to witness the aircraft land and shutdown for members to meet the crew and inspect the helicopter until they had to take off for a call. Alaina Starke, RN of Haynes Life Flight, presented information on patient treatment offered on the helicopter including Ventilation, Medicines, and Blood Product. Discussion of where the helicopter is capable of landing included the private field at Jones Corner and Driftwood, Church parking lots and the highway if necessary. The landing requirement of 100' x 100' for a night landing and 50' x 50' for a daylight landing and our VFDs are utilized to clear and prep the landing sites. Haynes has a LifeFlight program and Alaina explained the cost of the Life Flight and the membership program, which is \$75 yearly for a household.


Mrs. Barbara Dreyer



*Two letters of recommendation to include contact information.

*One Page Essay addressing the following question:

What are environmental issues that you feel most affect Lake Jordan and the surrounding lakes? How do you think you could participate to help improve or resolve this problem?

*Must be a family member of Lake Jordan HOBO Association

(Include family member name and contact information)

*Participate in a minimum of 8 hours of community service volunteer activities.

Preference is given for community service done at Lake Jordan.
